The CCL Community College Library Award is presented at the CCL Annual Meeting to recognize a person who has made an outstanding contribution toward librarianship in the California community colleges.

Criteria: Nominees should have demonstrated significant achievement in one or more of the following categories:

1. Significant achievement in development and implementation of a unique and innovative library program or project.
2. Significant achievement in advocacy of library programs or services.
3. Demonstrated leadership in professional organizations that are associated with promoting the mission of community college libraries.
4. Participation and influence in library-related matters in the California community college decision-making arena.
5. Leadership role in developing goals and outcomes for community college libraries in the field of information technology.

Nomination Procedure:

Nominations will be accepted by the Executive Committee throughout the year; in addition, a call for nominations will be announced annually in the *CCL Outlook*. Nominations for the CCL Community College Library Achievement Award should include a brief summary of the nominee's contribution, a brief resume or curriculum vitae, and the names of three references who can be contacted for further information.
